Background

For more than twenty years, the North Carolina Association of Educators (NCAE) has sponsored a Martin Luther King, Jr., Banquet in mid-January. The banquet is a fundraising activity for college scholarships that go to students without regard to race, religion, creed, or national origin. The banquet also serves as a forum for the recognition of the winners of the Minority Affairs art contest. Normally, the banquet is attended by 150 - 200 people, including NCAE members, student contest winners, their parents, community leaders and public officials. **At the January 16, 2009 MLK Banquet, NCAE will present an *Excellence in Equity* award(s).**

The distance to Raleigh for a Friday evening program often prevents some of the citizens of the state from participating. For the last several years, the NCAE Human Relations Commission and the NCAE Minority Affairs Commission has invited colleagues and friends from all over the state to participate in the fundraising by purchasing an advertisement in the printed program of the banquet.
